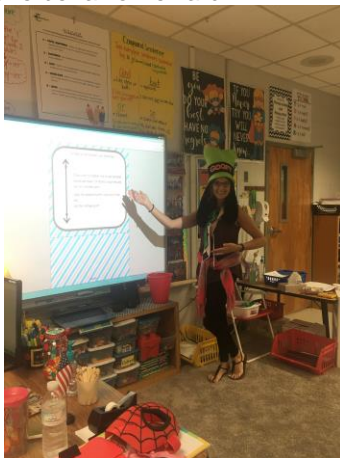
The school lunchroom was trying out a new meatloaf recipe and students were offered a sample. These students said it was "YUMMY!"
