Red Ribbon Week

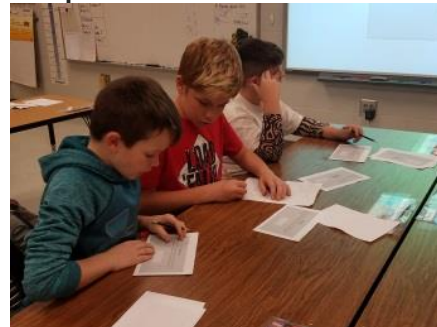
Red Ribbon Week was a great success at HES as students learned ways to say NO to drugs! On Thursday and Friday of last week, HES students celebrated Wear Red

Students in first grade are building with partners during STEM time. Barbie beds, soccer balls, and giraffes are among the creations.



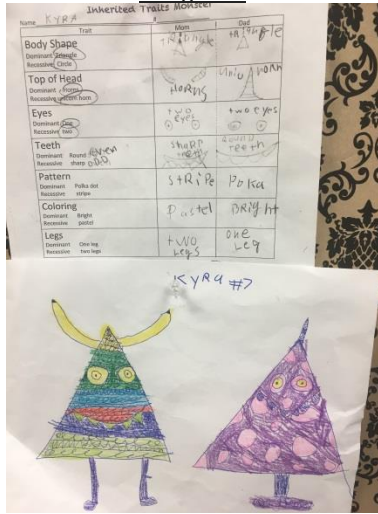
First grade had so much fun on Halloween conducting a science experiment to see what would happen to candy corn when submerged into water, water and vinegar, water and baking soda, and water and salt.

Inherited Trait Monsters!! Mrs. Lukens' 5th grade Science.

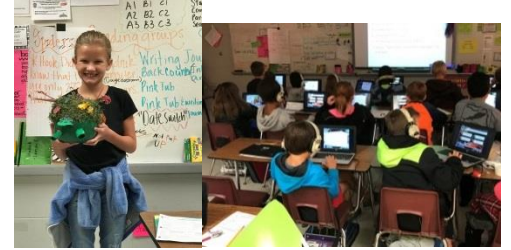


A sweet Science lesson on Halloween!!! Dominant and recessive traits with monsters!!!
