Jump Rope For Heart

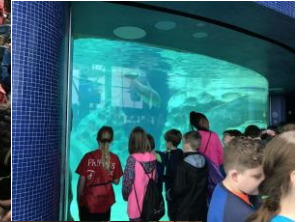

Kindergarten enjoyed eating green eggs and ham-- and even asked for more! Happy Birthday Dr. Seuss!



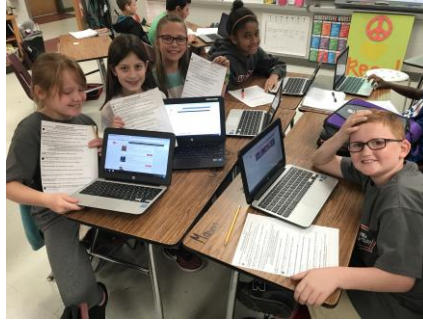
First graders are shown with student teacher, Elizabeth Maxwell as they celebrate Wacky Wednesday!
