1st grade had so much fun at the Flint River Aquarium. We were able to have a science lab class and the students loved the touch tank!!





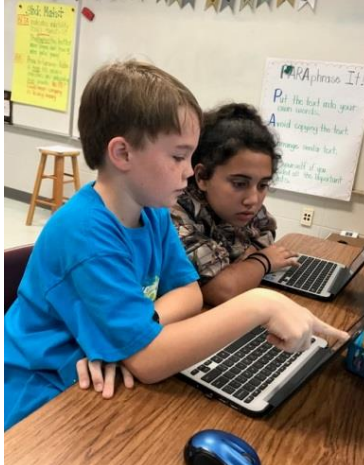
