 principal, and Mrs. Jennifer Lukens, CPIE Coordinator, were special guests and enjoyed sharing breakfast with the students.

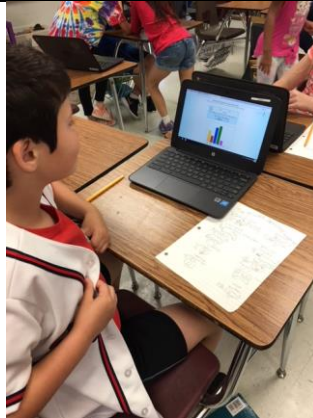

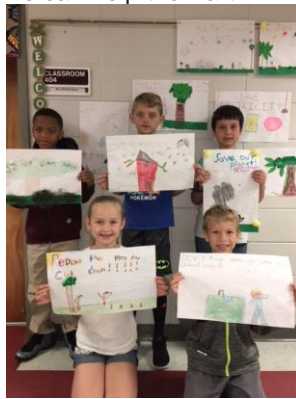


Engaging Lessons

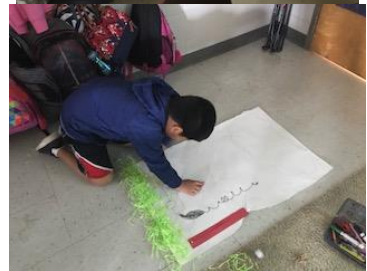
Third graders constructed pollution and conservation posters to show how we can help the Earth.
