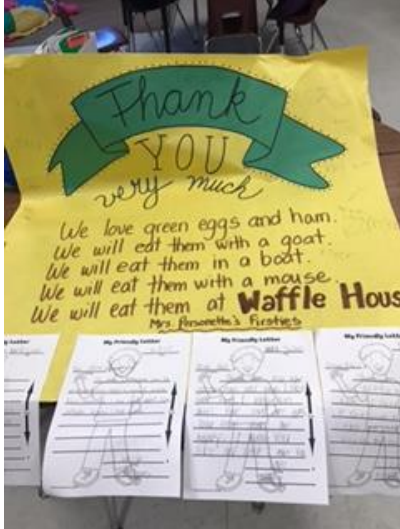
## Engaging Lessons

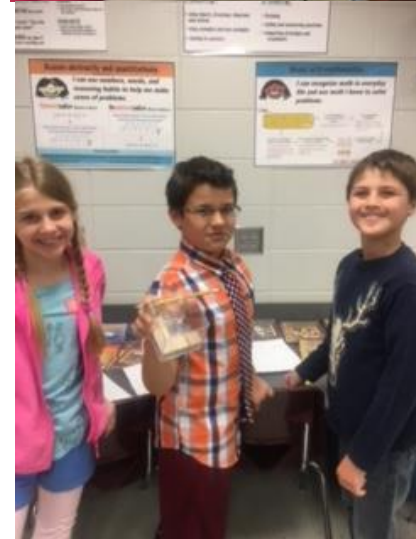
