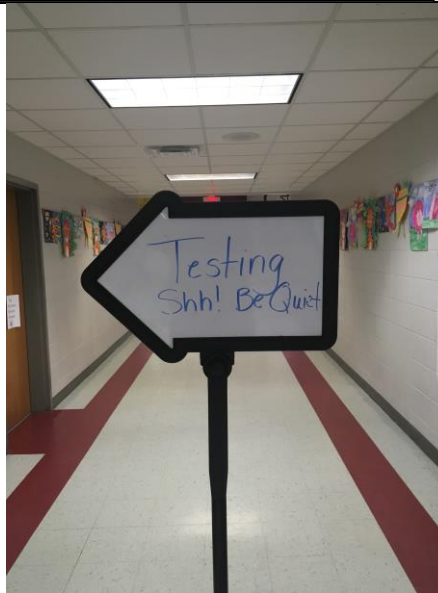

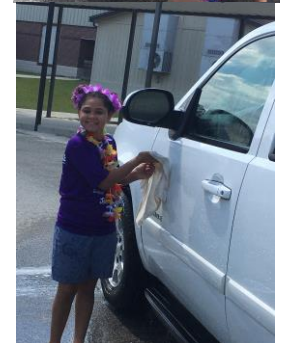
Georgia Milestones Testing
