Fairy Tale Ball

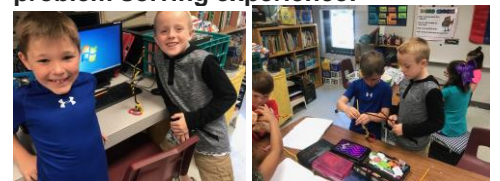

Nurses Honored

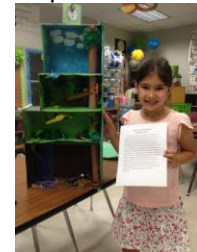
