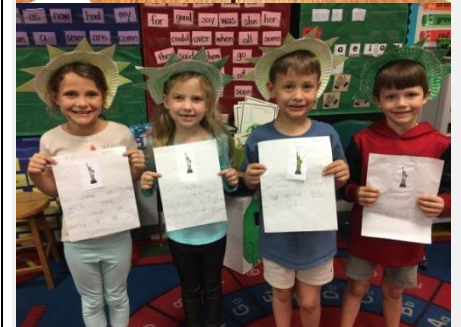
PBIS Walkthrough
